

NICS Social Club Code of Conduct

Members must:

- Use their membership cards to gain admission to the Pavilion premises
- Produce their valid membership card when requested to do so by an Association or Club official or by a member of the Pavilion staff

Guests must:

- Remain in the company of the member who signed them in
- Leave the premises when the member who signed them in leaves the premises

Members and their guests must:

- Conduct themselves in a reasonable and responsible manner, respecting other users of the Pavilion premises
- Observe all licensing laws and leave the Pavilion premises within 30 minutes of the closing of the bar
- Dress in an acceptable manner
- Observe the "no smoking" policy and smoke only in designated areas using ash trays and bins appropriately for the disposal of waste
- Report immediately all accidents, incidents and faults to an official of the Association or Club, or to a member of the Pavilion staff
- Observe all health and safety regulations, using only the designated area in the Pavilion Reception for the storage of sports bags, etc.
- Follow any reasonable instruction given by an Association or Club official or by a member of the Pavilion staff
- Park vehicles only in designated areas

Under 18's must:

- Be under the control of a responsible adult at all times whilst in the Pavilion premises

Members must not:

- Introduce as a guest any person who has been an unsuccessful candidate for membership of the Association or Club or whose membership is suspended or cancelled or any person whose reputation or conduct is objectionable.

Members and their guests must not:

- Use foul, abusive or offensive language
- Cause any offence, annoyance or disturbance to other users of the Pavilion premises
- Wear, or have in their possession, in the Pavilion premises clothing or articles of any sort which could cause serious annoyance or offence to other users of the Pavilion premises
- Enter the bar or restaurant area after/during taking part in sporting activities without having changed into appropriate attire
- Abuse, mistreat, damage or remove any property or items belonging to the Social Club or the Sports Association
- Take any animal, except a Guide dog, anywhere inside the Pavilion premises
- Park vehicles inappropriately in disabled parking spaces
- Assist any other person to improperly enter the Pavilion premises
